2010 TPWA Award Program

Purpose	This award recognizes outstanding and meritorious achievement of individuals assisting in the areas of continuing and/or graduate professional education for public works professionals.
Eligibility	Candidates must be members of TPWA.
Selection	The TPWA Awards Committee reviews the nominations and selects the award winner.
Nomination Process	Nominations must be made by Texas Chapter members. Submittals should detail the nominee's activity relative to education for public works professionals. Original submittal should include the nomination form and documentation supporting the purpose of the award and the award's eligibility requirements. Seven copies of the submittal are required. These materials should be sent to the Texas Chapter Awards Chair (address can be found on the TPWA Website). Materials submitted in support of nomination will not be returned.
Deadline	May 1, 2010
Presentation	The winner is presented with a plaque at the Awards Banquet during the TPWA Annual Conference.
