



Professional Manager of the Year Award Engineering and Technology

2010 TPWA Awards Program

Purpose	The Professional Manager of the Year Award in the Engineering and Technology category seeks to inspire excellence and dedication in the private and public sectors by recognizing the outstanding career service achievements of engineering and technology professionals. The primary focus of this award is recognition of exceptional leadership and management in the area of engineering and technology.
Eligibility	Candidates must meet all the following criteria: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Be an active member of TPWA whose primary responsibility is the management of public works engineering and/or technology.2. Must have 10 years of qualifying experience.3. Employed by either the public or private sector with career service in public works engineering and technology.4. Must manage a diverse engineering and technology service delivery program characterized by creative engineering activities with a record of developing/utilizing/leveraging technology.
Selection	The TPWA Awards Committee reviews the nominations and selects the award winner. Criteria will include: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Significant contributions to the advancement of Engineering and Technology management.2. Outstanding leadership and vision evidenced by employing progressive management techniques in the area of engineering and technology.3. Employment of new and innovative ideas and technology resulting in the advancement of the effectiveness of engineering and technology management.4. Implementation of effective methods to optimize fiscal management of engineering and technology operations.5. Maintenance of a high degree of satisfaction among customers and other stakeholders.6. Promotion of the field of engineering and technology management in the community, agency or customers served.
Nomination	Nominations may be made by Texas Chapter members, a community organization, or a public agency. Original submittal should include the nomination form and the award's eligibility requirements. . Seven copies of the submittal are required. These materials should be sent to the Texas Chapter Awards Chair (address can be found on the TPWA Website). Materials submitted in support of nomination will not be returned.
Deadline	May 1, 2010
Presentation	The winner is presented with a plaque at the Awards Banquet during the TPWA Annual Conference.
