



## **Professional Manager of the Year Award Public Fleet**

### **2010 TPWA Awards Program**

<b>Purpose</b>	The Professional Manager of the Year Award in the Public Fleet category seeks to inspire excellence and dedication in the private and public sectors by recognizing the outstanding career service achievements of public fleet management professionals. The primary focus of this award is recognition of exceptional leadership and management in the area of public sector fleets.
<b>Eligibility</b>	Candidates must meet all the following criteria: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Be an active member of TPWA whose primary responsibility is the management of public works fleet.</li><li>2. Must have 10 years of qualifying experience.</li><li>3. Employed by either the public or private sector with career service in the management of public sector fleet.</li><li>4. Must manage a diverse fleet of equipment utilized in providing essential public service functions.</li></ol>
<b>Selection</b>	The TPWA Awards Committee reviews the nominations and selects the award winner. Criteria will include: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Significant contributions to the advancement of Public Fleet management.</li><li>2. Outstanding leadership and vision evidenced by employing progressive management techniques in the area of Public Fleet management.</li><li>3. Employment of new and innovative ideas and technology resulting in the advancement of the effectiveness of Public Fleet management.</li><li>4. Implementation of effective methods to optimize fiscal management of Public Fleet operations.</li><li>5. Maintenance of a high degree of satisfaction among customers and other stakeholders.</li><li>6. Promotion of the field of Public Fleet management in the community, agency or customers served.</li></ol>
<b>Nomination</b>	Nominations may be made by Texas Chapter members, a community organization, or a public agency. Original submittal should include the nomination form and the award's eligibility requirements. Seven copies of the submittal are required. These materials should be sent to the Texas Chapter Awards Chair (address can be found on the TPWA Website). Materials submitted in support of nomination will not be returned.
<b>Deadline</b>	May 1, 2010
<b>Presentation</b>	The winner is presented with a plaque at the Awards Banquet during the TPWA Annual Conference.
