



## **Professional Manager of the Year Award Public Right-of-Way**

### **2010 TPWA Awards Program**

<b>Purpose</b>	The Professional Manager of the Year Award in the Public Right-of-Way category seeks to inspire excellence and dedication in the private and public sectors by recognizing the outstanding career service achievements of public right-of-way professionals. The primary focus of this award is the recognition of the management of the public rights-of-way which demonstrates that all stakeholders share the public rights-of-way in harmony and preserve them in the best interest and benefit of the public.
<b>Eligibility</b>	Candidates must meet all the following criteria: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Be an active member of TPWA whose primary responsibility is the right-of-way management.</li><li>2. Employed by either the public or private sector with career service in public right-of-way management.</li></ol>
<b>Selection</b>	The TPWA Awards Committee reviews the nominations and selects the award winner. Criteria will include: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Significant contributions to the advancement of Public Right-of-Way management.</li><li>2. Outstanding leadership and vision evidenced by employing progressive management techniques in the area of Public Right-of-Way management.</li><li>3. Employment of new and innovative ideas and technology resulting in the advancement of the effectiveness of Public Right-of-Way management.</li><li>4. Implementation of effective methods to optimize fiscal management of Public Right-of-Way operations.</li><li>5. Maintenance of a high degree of satisfaction among customers and other stakeholders.</li><li>6. Promotion of the field of Public Right-of-Way management in the community, agency or customers served.</li></ol>
<b>Nomination</b>	Nominations may be made by Texas Chapter members, a community organization, or a public agency. Original submittal should include the nomination form and the award's eligibility requirements. Seven copies of the submittal are required. These materials should be sent to the Texas Chapter Awards Chair (address can be found on the TPWA Website). Materials submitted in support of nomination will not be returned.
<b>Deadline</b>	May 1, 2010
<b>Presentation</b>	The winner is presented with a plaque at the Awards Banquet during the TPWA Annual Conference.
