## **Field Excellence Award 2012 TPWA Awards Program**

- Purpose** To recognize an individual, team or organization for actions in the field having significant impact on services meeting the goals of public works in serving the public and protecting the environment. Nominations are to be considered on the basis of customer service, innovation, cost savings, increased productivity, and/or other significant achievements.
- This award recognizes an employee or employees working in a non-management position, whose actions in the field had a significant impact on public services.
- Eligibility** Candidates must be employed by a Texas Public Agency and work in a non-management position. APWA membership is not required.
- Selection** The TPWA Awards Committee reviews the nominations and selects the award winner based on the following criteria:
- Each nomination is judged on the effect upon the provisions of goods and services to the public. It can be an action, innovation in the process itself, or in the materials, equipment, procurement of, etc. that improves, informs, or educates the delivery of public services and improves the quality of life.
  - The action/innovation to which is being nominated must be documented and presentable with sufficient information to allow documentation for the Awards Committee.
  - The action/innovation must have had a significant impact, not just a natural evolution of existing methods, common sense or good practice.
- Nomination** Nominations can be made by any public agency or APWA Texas Chapter member. The original submittal should include the nomination form and documentation supporting the purpose of the award and the award's eligibility requirements. - Deadline** January 6, 2012
- Presentation** The winner will be recognized at the TPWA Short Course.
